



10 GOOD REASONS

TO JOIN THE PSA

1. The voice of the public sector

The PSA represents the workplace interests of tens of thousands of public servants who perform a range of vital services across NSW Government departments and agencies, including schools.

2. Improved wages and entitlements

Employers do not automatically hand over salary increases and better conditions.

The PSA is constantly fighting for improved pay and entitlements for members along with job security, innovative workplace measures and rights at work.

3. Safer workplaces

Bullying, harassment, excessive workloads and physical hazards are all work health and safety issues the PSA can tackle by having a strong and united voice in the workplace.

The PSA also fights to ensure workers have a fair compensation system in the event of an injury at work.

4. Value added services

The PSA offers a range of non-industrial benefits: Union Shopper, low cost banking and loans with SCU Credit Union, a Provident Fund (\$3,500 for beneficiaries), Journey and Personal Injury Insurance, and free initial legal advice for non-industrial matters (conditions apply).

5. Reasonable fees

Union fees are tax deductible and based on income.

6. Democracy

The PSA is a democratic union with its direction determined by members who elect workplace delegates from across the state.

Delegates work with PSA staff to negotiate improved pay and conditions and protect members' interests.

7. Advice and advocacy

The PSA has a dedicated Member Support Centre and a team of experienced industrial advocates.

Whether advice on entitlements or more complex issues is required, the PSA provides assistance and ensures members are treated fairly.

8. Training

PSA members have access to free training on a range of topics including dealing with workplace bullying, role of the delegate, union campaigning and public speaking.

9. Job protection

The PSA is a staunch supporter of and advocate for a well-resourced NSW public sector.

That means standing up for its members, their jobs and the services they provide.

10. Collective strength

Joining the union makes the PSA stronger.

A united unionised workplace means a united voice.
