TRANSGRID MEMBERS INDUSTRIAL BULLETIN

Dear Members,

On 4 October 2012 the Managing Director, Transgrid emailed staff concerning Transgrid's intention to pursue an efficiency drive across the organisation.

The CPSU has been contacted by numerous members concerned with the implications of these proposals if implemented.

Particular concerns relates to a proposal to appoint new staff at Sydney office without access to a 9 day fortnight.

Transgrid has also foreshadowed more focus on the use of individual flexibility agreements, reduction in excess annual leave accruals and reductions to overtime, sustenance and travelling time claims.

There is also a proposal to relocate staff from the Sydney and Wallgrove offices to a new building at Ultimo in 2013.

The CPSU has written to Transgrid requesting consultation with unions as required by the enterprise agreement where significant change to working arrangements are proposed by the employer.

The CPSU also wants your feedback in relation to the proposals by participating in a survey to help us establish the facts around Transgrid's efficiency drive.
