The Primary Principals Association has also expressed grave concerns and has raised these with the Minister and the Deputy Director General Peter Riordan.

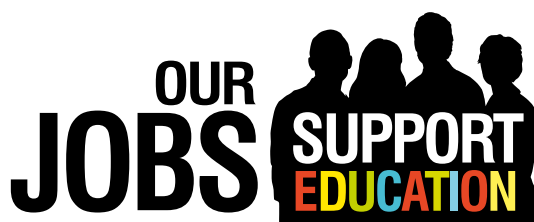
