Parliamentary Inquiry into Bullying at WorkCover

Members will be aware that an Upper House Committee of the NSW Parliament has released the report of its inquiry into allegations of bullying at WorkCover.

The Parliamentary Inquiry followed a decision in the NSW Industrial Relations Commission on 21 June 2013 about the unfair dismissal of a WorkCover employee. Deputy President Harrison of the Commission said in his decision that the investigation used by WorkCover to justify the dismissal of Mr Butler was a "witch hunt" and "institutional bullying".

The SRWS PSA Delegates Committee will be meeting soon to review the Inquiry report's findings and recommendations.
