Service NSW have agreed to waive the '6 month rule' for staff at these locations.

108 substantive staff plus 24 placed staff are directly affected by these mergers/relocations.

120 roles in Service NSW will be advertised by the end of August and a further 80 roles will be advertised by the end of 2015.

Service NSW has committed to providing pre-interview training at all the affected sites.
