The establishment of the PSA's Bargaining Team is an opportunity to maximise member involvement in bargaining for member's wages and conditions.

As a part of this process, Bargaining Team Delegates will communicate and consult with local members, attend Bargaining Team meetings and act as a conduit to ensure member's views are represented.

To enable this, Delegates will:

- Work to build union power and recruit members around the issue of pay and conditions
- Organise and attend member meetings, both in their own agency and other agencies in the local community
- Develop communications to members for the purpose of consultation and feedback
- Attend Bargaining Team training (as required)
- Have a commitment to union principles
- Be able to work as part of a team.
