

Petition against the

Privatisation of Land and Property Information

To the Honourable the Speaker and Members of the Legislative Assembly of New SouthWales.

The Petition of certain citizens of New South Wales brings to the attention of the House that the proposed privatisation of Land and Property Information will jeopardise a public service that underpins \$130 billion of economic activity.

Land and Property Information has anchored the NSW economy for over a century. Privatising this core service would undermine the stability of the state during times of global uncertainty. LPI generates millions of dollars in profit that allows the government to invest in schools, healthcare and other core services. Privatising LPI would cut this revenue and slash services – short-term profits willcreate long-term pain for the people of New South Wales.

The undersigned petitioners therefore ask the Legislative Assembly to cease the privatisation of Land and Property Information immediately.
