5. Reasonable fees

Union fees are tax deductible and based on income.

6. Democracy

The CPSU NSW is a democratic union with its direction determined by members who elect workplace delegates from across the state.

Delegates work with CPSU NSW staff to negotiate improved pay and conditions and protect members' interests.

7. Advice and advocacy

The CPSU NSW has a dedicated Member Support Centre and a team of experienced industrial advocates.

Whether advice on entitlements or more complex issues is required, the CPSU NSW provides assistance and ensures members are treated fairly.

8. Training

CPSU NSW members have access to free training on a range of topics including dealing with workplace bullying, role of the delegate, union campaigning and public speaking.

9. Job protection

The CPSU NSW is a staunch supporter of and advocate for a well-resourced NSW public sector.

That means standing up for its members, their jobs and the services they provide.

10. Collective strength

Joining the union makes the CPSU NSW stronger. A united unionised workplace means a united voice. United we bargain, divided we beg. It's that simple.
