AGREEMENT made the seventeenthday of January in the year 1974 BETWEEN HAROLD HERBERT DICKINSON

JACK WALLIS DAVIES WILLIAM HEDLEY GENT and GERALD GLEESON

Members of the Public Service Board for the State of New South

Wales all of Sydney in the said State (hereinafter called the Board) of the one part and THE PUBLIC SERVICE ASSOCIATION OF

NEW SOUTH WALES being an Association or Organisation representing certain classes of Public Servants (hereinafter called the Association) of the other part.

(1) INTRODUCTORY

This Agreement is made between the Board and the Association in pursuance of the provisions of Section 14B of the Public Service Act, 1902.

This Agreement shall be binding upon the Board and all officers as defined herein.

(2) DEFINITIONS

"Officer" means and includes all persons permanently or temporarily employed under the provisions of the Public Service Act, 1902, and who, at the beginning of the first pay period to commence on or after 1st January, 1973, were occupying one of the positions covered by this Agreement, or who, after that date, are appointed to one of such positions, but does not include any person who resigned, or whose services were terminated prior to the date of the signing of this Agreement.

"Service" means continuous service. Future appointees shall be deemed to have the years of service indicated by the salaries at which they are appointed.

(3) SALARIES

Subject to the provisions of the Public Service Act, 1902, and the Regulations thereunder, the following shall be the salaries to be paid to officers appointed to the positions specified:

(4) GENERAL

It is agreed that the salaries of positions, covered by this Agreement shall be subject to review following variation in rates of pay of employees paid in terms of the Crown Employees (Storemen etc.) Award.

(5) WAGE BASIS

The salaries prescribed in Clause (3), Salaries, of this Agreement, on and from the beginning of the first pay period to commence on or after 1st January, 1973, are based on a basic wage for adult males of \$41.10 per week and on and from the 29th May 1973, are based on a basic wage for adult males of \$44.40 per week.

Such salaries shall be varied from time to time following any determination of the Industrial Commission of New South Wales made pursuant to Section 57 of the Industrial Arbitration Act, 1940, in like manner as if this Agreement were an Award prescribing annual rates of salaries to which the provisions of that Act apply, provided that the salaries as so varied shall be adjusted to the nearest dollar.

(6) AREA, INCIDENCE AND DURATION

This Agreement rescinds and replaces Agreement No. 1740 of 1971 made on the twenty-fourth day of June, 1971, in so far as it relates to the officers referred to herein.

It shall apply to all officers as defined herein and shall have effect for a period of two years on and from the beginning of the first pay period to commence on or after the first day of January, 1973, and shall continue in force thereafter until one month's notice of its termination is given by either party.
