**SECTION 63(1) DETERMINATION NO. 929 OF 2002**

**1. INTRODUCTION**

The Public Employment Office has determined, pursuant to section 63(1) of the *Public Sector Management Act 1988*, the classification of Coordinator, Visual Arts.

**2. DEFINITIONS**

“Coordinator, Visual Arts” means an officer or temporary employee engaged in that classification.

“Officer” means a person appointed under the *Public Sector Management Act 1988* to positions classified and graded in accordance with this determination.

“Temporary employee” means a person employed under section 38 of the *Public Sector Manager Act 1988* to work classified and graded in accordance with this determination.

**3. RATES OF PAY**

The rate of pay for an officer or temporary employee engaged as Coordinator, Visual Arts is set out in Table 1 – Salary.

**4. ALLOWANCES**

The Coordinator, Visual Arts shall received the following allowances:

- a) Environmental Allowance as set out in Table 2 – Allowances – as recognition that the position has substantial, regular and direct contact with inmates; and

- b) All Incidents Allowance as set out in Table 2 – Allowances - as compensation for out of hours, weekend and public holiday work and for any additional hours of work.

The allowances shall be paid as salary, but shall not be considered salary for any purpose, including superannuation.

Allowances will be adjusted in accordance with the Crown Employees (Public Sector – Salaries January 2002) Award or any award made replacing that award.

## 5. EMPLOYMENT CONDITIONS

Except where specifically varied by this determination, the Crown Employees (Public Sector Condition of Employment 1997) Award and the Crown Employees (Public Sector – Salaries January 2002) Award or any award replacing those awards shall apply.

## 6. DATE OF EFFECT

This Determination shall take effect on and from the date of signing.
