WITHOUT PREJUDICE

Re: Meal and Crib Break Radio Operations Centres

I refer to your letter dated 18 September 2017 re: *Changes to Communications Centre Meal and Crib Breaks*.

As previously stated, it remains the position of the NSWPF that the 50/20 roster is the correct agreed roster pattern for the Radio Operations Group (ROG). This is evidenced by the 'Administrative Guidelines for the Commencement of 12 hour Roster on 1.1.95'.

In the interest of resolving this matter, I am prepared to offer the following:

- a) The continuation of the current 50/20 roster, or,
- b) Implementation of a 50 minute meal break and 30 minute crib break ('50/30') on the basis that the ad-hoc breaks that officers currently access at their discretion are subject to approval by their shift supervisor. In effect, this means officers would otherwise not be leaving their desk for ad-hoc breaks (excluding reasonable bathroom breaks) without prior permission from their shift supervisor.

Please let me know if you would like to meet and discuss this offer, otherwise please respond to be by COB Thursday 30 November 2017.
