Member vote on management proposal to resolve meal/Crib breaks dispute

As members will be aware, meal and crib breaks were reduced across ROG in August 2017.

Members resolved to implement work bans to protest this change which were lifted a week later following an order from the Industrial Relations Commission.

Delegates and PSA industrial staff have been in protracted negotiations with ROG management since the lifting of the work bans and a final proposal from management has been received in a letter [HERE](#)
