On 10 October 2018 FACS made the announcement about the transferring of CJP/ISP direct services to the Non-Government Sector on 13 December 2018. As a part of this announcement, consultation with our employees and the relevant Unions commenced.

Following the consultation with the Unions last week, FACS has made the decision to release the registration of interest for the Senior Clinical Consultants.

As a part of the transferring direct services will include 4x ongoing Senior Clinical Consultants to continue provide care to our clients. We have more Senior Clinical Consultants (ongoing) than required to transfer, therefore, we have developed the 'translation principles' to provide transparency process, maintain equity between employees and attempt to minimise disruption to employees and operations.
