**RECOMMENDATION**

COMMISSIONER: The Industrial Relations Commission recommends that Corrective Services New South Wales maintains the status quo in relation to overtime payments made where staff are called late for an overtime shift. That is, staff have up to two hours from the time called to present for the shift to be paid for the full shift. Staff who take more than two hours to present for the shift will be paid for time worked.

If Corrective Services New South Wales wishes to alter these arrangements, it will formally write to the Association to advise this and engage in consultations with the Association.
