Structural Realignment – Office for Police

I am writing to formally notify you of the structural realignment involving the Office for Police. The structural change is necessary to build on, and enhance the quality of community safety strategy and operational policy advice, and improve service to both the Minister for Police and Attorney General.

The realignment involves the transferring of the following functions (including roles and employees) from the Office for Police to other agencies within the NSW Public Sector as follows:

- Capability Intelligence and Biometrics to the NSW Police Force;
- Community Safety and Rural Crime to the NSW Police Force;
- Counter Terrorism to the Department of Justice;
- Major Crime and Firearms to the Department of Justice and NSW Police Force; and
- Resourcing and Reform to the Department of Justice.

This structural realignment involves no reduction, or increase in non-executive roles, results in all roles remaining in the Sydney CBD, and affects 33 employees. There are no changes to role descriptions with the exception of minor changes to reflect changes to agency names and reporting lines.

The affected employees have been advised of the structural changes in a meeting held earlier today, with all employees provided with correspondence notifying them of the realignment.
