COURSE OUTLINE

Work Health and Safety

The two-day course looks at various rights, entitlements and obligations under the *WHS Act 2011* that underpin a safe and healthy workplace including:

- Finding your way around the *WHS Act*
- WHS duties – who has a WHS duty and what is that duty?
- Consultation – the what, when and how of proper workplace consultation
- Issue Resolution using WHS legislation – is my issue covered under WHS legislation?
- Health & Safety Representatives (HSR) – what is a HSR and how do you get one?
- Risk management and workplace inspections.
