Access to Flexitime

Members in GRR have raised concerns about access to Flexitime, particularly the inability to accrue Flexitime due to the direction not to work longer than seven hours 30 minutes each day – and that can only occur with the agreement of your Supervisor.

There appears to have been a unilateral decision made some time ago involving a major change to staff operations with no consultation with the PSA occurring. This approach sits outside of the Flexible Working Hours Agreement (FWHA) which the PSA negotiated with Departmental Management.

Members have expressed concern and frustration over this approach which greatly impacts on their work/life balance. The PSA has made representations to Management and the issue will be addressed in the near future.

The PSA is YOUR UNION and will continue to fight for your rights and entitlements at work. Workers are “STRONGER TOGETHER” so talk to your colleagues and suggest that they become PSA members, too.
