Re: Members of Parliament Staff (MoPS) and Parliamentary Senior Officers – Presiding Officers
Determination/s – 2021/22 Public Sector 2.5% Salary/Super Increase

I refer to the Members' Staff Conditions of Employment – Determination of the Presiding Officers and the Parliamentary Senior Officers – Annual Determination of Salary Policy.

Both of these instruments have salary increases that covered the period 1 July 2020 to 30 June 2021 and make reference to the NSW Government Wages Policy in regards to movements of salaries. Departmental staff benefit from the centrally negotiated changes to the Crown Employees (Public Sector Salaries) Award.

The Parliament received confirmation from the Department of Premier and Cabinet on 28 June 2021 advising of the Government's approved 2.5 per cent increase. This increase is to comprise of 2.04 per cent to salary and a 0.5 per cent increase to superannuation for one year.

It is therefore proposed that the Association agree to the 2021/22 public sector salary increase for both of the above mentioned Determinations. This increase is to apply from the first full pay period after 1 July 2021.

If the Association agrees to the offer, could you please advise this acceptance by return email as soon as possible. The Parliament (HR Operations) will then process the associated lump sum payments to give effect to those increases.
