University Undergraduate Scholarship

CONDITIONS

Applications close at the end of February each year.

- 1. The Scholarship is available at any Australian university in any course.
- 2. The Scholarship is restricted to students entering the first year of a full-time course. Eligible applicants must have sat their HSC in 2023.
- 3. The Scholarship is restricted to:
 - (a) children of members of the Association at the time of application who have been continuous financial members for the previous five years; or
 - (b) children of members employed in universities, the Department of Community Services or the Department of Juvenile Justice who have five years' continuous membership of the HREA and PSA.
- 4. The Scholarship will have a value of \$2000 per annum.
- 5. The Scholarship will be awarded in the first instance for one year and will be reawarded annually for a maximum period of three years. A scholar's tenure shall be subject to a satisfactory report as to his/her progress and conduct.
- 6. The Scholarship will be awarded on results obtained in Higher School Certificate Examination and Assessment or equivalent and the award will take into account whether or not the applicant is the holder of a Scholarship, Traineeship, etc.
- 7. Subject to the provisions of Condition No. 6, the highest marks and assessment and/or aggregate will be the deciding factor in the award.
