Minister John Graham is cutting frontline roles at the Art Gallery of NSW, putting exhibitions at risk.

The NSW Government has the Art Gallery of NSW in its sights. Arts Minister John Graham wants to cut more than 50 staff, largely focused on the frontline workers who make the gallery one of the country's most engaging cultural experiences for visitors both local and from outside Sydney.

Highly paid senior executives have largely been spared the Minister's knife. Instead cuts are aimed at the people who present exhibitions, keep visitors safe, and maintain one of Sydney's finest public buildings. Without them, your trip to the gallery

will be diminished. Anyone can see art on a page or a screen, but it is the dedicated staff at the Art Gallery of NSW who create an immersive experience for cultural aficionados.
