CONDITIONS**

Applications close at the end of February each year.

1. The Scholarship is available at any Australian university in any course.
2. The Scholarship is restricted to students entering the first year of a full-time course.
3. The Scholarship is restricted to:
 - (a) women members of the Association at the time of application who have been continuous financial members for the previous five years; or
 - (b) women members employed in universities, the Department of Community Services or the Department of Juvenile Justice who have five years' continuous membership of the HREA and PSA.
4. The Scholarship will have a value of \$2000 per annum.
5. The Scholarship will be awarded in the first instance for one year and will be re-awarded annually for a maximum period of three years. A scholar's tenure shall be subject to a satisfactory report as to his/her progress and conduct.
6. The Scholarship will be awarded by selection after the Executive review the application and consider all factors in the selection criteria addressed in a short summary by the applicant including socio-economic circumstances, academic potential, personal motivation, commitment to union values and commitment to studies.
