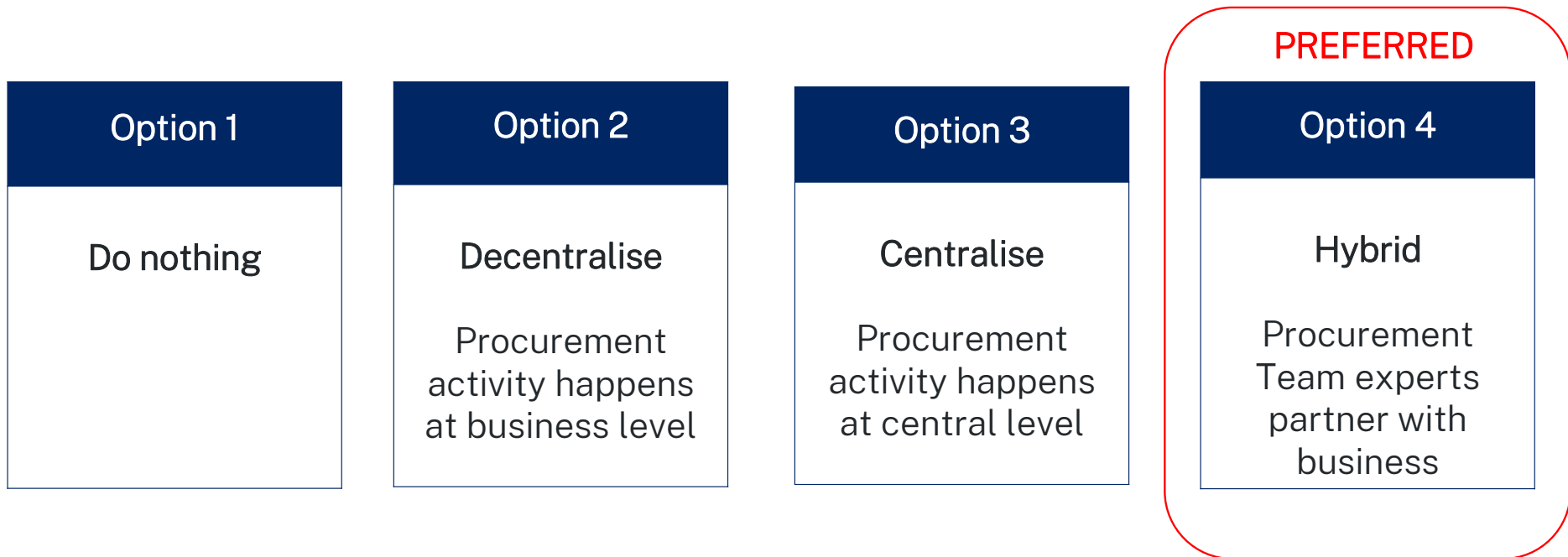
Current structure – Procurement team

Proposed organisational changes - why

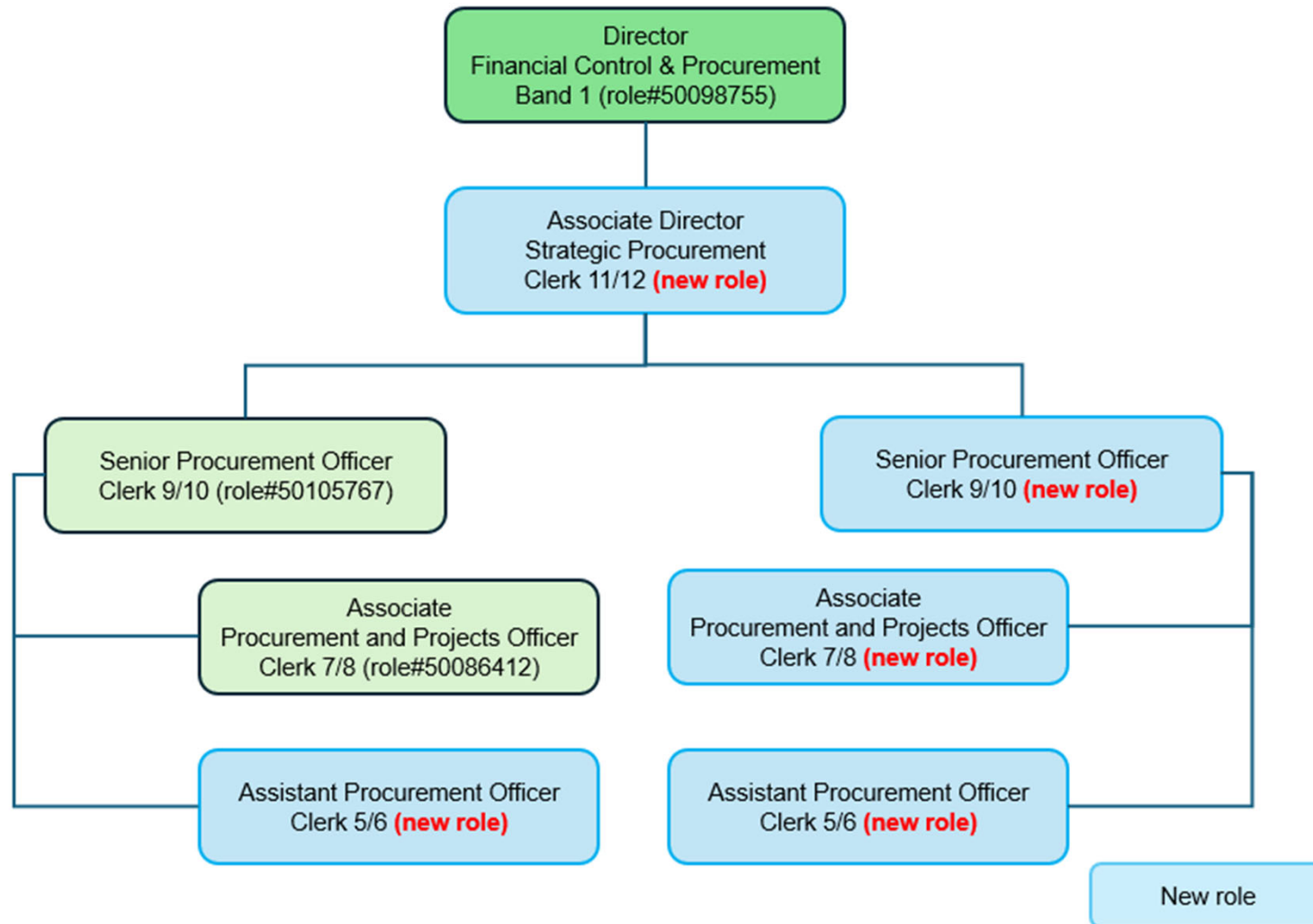
Context
